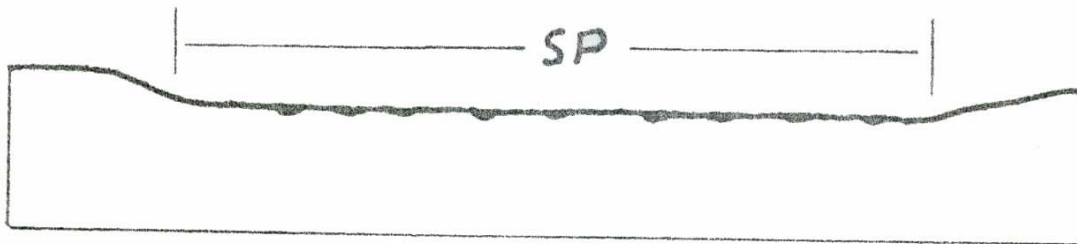


MAP UNIT

GENERAL DESCRIPTION

Flat to very gently sloping plain. Usually poorly drained and often gilgaied (Crab holey). Soils are deep, yellow grey duplex with heavy clay, high shrink-swell, impermeable clays. Soil Parent Material : Ordovician, Tertiary & Alluvium

LAND ASSESSMENT

- A Erosion Risk with Land Disturbance
 - Class 1 Not much rapid runoff
- B Constraints on construction
 - Class 3(4) High shrink-swell poor drainage
- C Effluent Disposal by Soil Absorption
 - Class 4-5 Poor soil drainage
- D Small Farm Dams
 - Class 2

OVERALL ASSESSMENT FOR RURAL SUBDIVISION 2-10 ha (Considering A, B, C & D)

- Class 4 Flat & wet
