
MAP UNIT MAP SYMBOL TD



## **GENERAL DESCRIPTION**

Deep, steep gorge cut into the basalt plain. Slopes 20-50%. Soils are generally black cracking clays and steeper areas are rocky.

## LAND ASSESSMENT

- A Erosion Risk with Land Disturbance
  - Class 4 Steep short slopes
- B Constraints on Construction
  - Class 4-5 Very steep slopes. Some areas prone to landslip
- C Effluent Disposal by Soil Absorption
  - Class 5 Too steep, slow percolation, shallow soil, close to creek
- D Small Farm Dams
  - Class 5 Too steep

## OVERALL ASSESSMENT FOR RURAL SUBDIVISION 2-10 ha (Considering A, B, C & D)

Class Too steep, unstable and with a high risk of pollution
