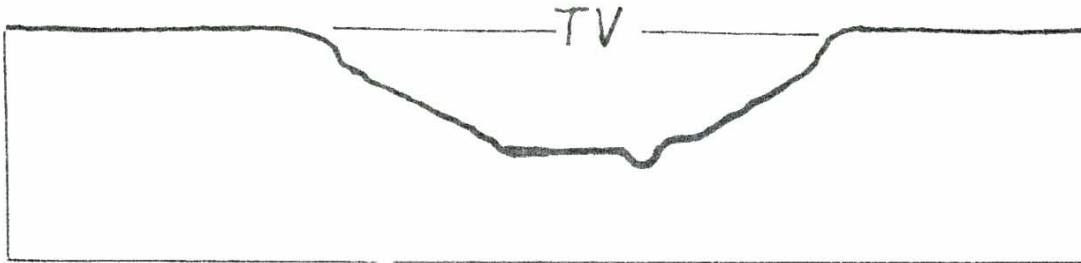


MAP UNIT

GENERAL DESCRIPTION

Moderately deep gorge cut into the basalt plain, often exposing the sedimentary rock below. Slopes are variable. The top lip of the slope may be rock. Soils are usually black clay. Slopes 10-20% - some short steeper slopes.
