
Land Conservation Act 1970 PROCLAMATION OF WATER SUPPLY CATCHMENTS

I, J. Davis McCaughey, Governor of Victoria, acting with the advice of the Executive Council, having considered a recommendation of the Land Conservation Council under section 5 (1) (b) of the Land Conservation Act 1970 (No. 8008) and acting under section 22 (1) of the Soil Conservation and Land Utilization Act 1958 (No. 6372), define the following areas as water supply catchment areas:

MUSICAL GULLY AND TROY RESERVOIRS (BEAUFORT) WATER SUPPLY CATCHMENTS


The catchments to service reservoirs controlled by the Beaufort Water Board, the wall of which, in the case of Musical Gully reservoir, is situated on an unnamed tributary within Crown allotment 7c, section A, Parish of Beaufort and, in the case of Troy reservoir, the wall of which is situated on an unnamed tributary within Crown allotment 4, section I (Water Supply Reserve), Parish of Beaufort and as indicated on Plan No. S-1473, hereunder, to be known as the Musical Gully and Troy Reservoirs (Beaufort) water supply catchment areas.

LANGI GHIRAN RESERVOIR (ARARAT) WATER SUPPLY CATCHMENT

The catchment to a service reservoir controlled by the City of Ararat, the wall of which is situated on Easter Creek within a Water Supply Reserve, section 1 in the Parish of Colvinsby and as indicated on Plan No. S-1474, hereunder, to be known as the Langi Ghiran Reservoir (Ararat) water supply catchment area.



PICNIC ROAD (ARARAT) WATER SUPPLY CATCHMENT

The catchment to a service reservoir, the wall of which the City of Ararat proposes to construct within Crown allotments 12L, 80 and 73, section 14 in the Parish of Ararat and as indicated on Plan No. S-1475, hereunder, to be known as the Picnic Road (Ararat) water supply catchment
