
FIERY CREEK TRIBUTARIES (BEAUFORT) WATER SUPPLY CATCHMENT

The sub-catchments to offtake weirs controlled by the Beaufort Water Board, situated on Side Spring within Reserved Forest in the Parish of Raglan West, in Long Gully within Reserved Forest in the Parish of Raglan West and on Cave Hill Creek within Reserved Forest in the Parish of Raglan West and as indicated on Plan No. S-1476, hereunder, to be known as the Fiery Creek Tributaries (Beaufort) water supply catchment area.



The use of land within this catchment is subject to specification by notice or by determination made by the Director-General, Department of Conservation, Forests and Lands, acting under section 22 (2) and section 23 (1) (a), (b) and (c) of the Soil Conservation and Land Utilization Act 1958, as amended.
