## **PROCLAMATION**


By His Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria, and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia &c., &c., &c.

I, THE Governor of the State of Victoria in the Commonwealth of Australia, by and with the advice of the Executive Council of the said State and in pursuance of the provisions contained in section 22 of the *Soil Conservation and Land Utilization Act* 1958 (No. 6372), do by this Proclamation define the water supply catchment area to be known as the Bunyip River Water Supply Catchment.

The Catchment is to be defined as "the whole catchment of the Bunyip River and its tributaries upstream of the diversion weir of the State Rivers and Water Supply Commission situated on the said Bunyip River in State forest in the Parish of Nayook West, County of Mornington, and being north 18 deg, 50 min. east, a distance of approximately 40,350 links from the north-westerly angle of Crown allotment 12, section C, Parish of Tonimbuk East".

The use of land within this catchment is subject to determination by the Soil Conservation Authority, acting under the provisions of section 23 (1) (a) of the *Soil Conservation and Land Utilization Act* 1958 (No. 6372).

The area described is more particularly defined on plan No. 1257 hereunder, the original of which is lodged at the Head Office of the Soil Conservation Authority, 378 Cotham Road, Kew, E4.
