PROCLAMATION


By His Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia, &c., &c., &c.

I, the Governor of the state of Victoria in the Commonwealth of Australia, by and with the advice of the Executive council of the said State and having considered a recommendation of the Land Conservation Council in pursuance of the provisions contained in Section 22 (1) of the *Soil Conservation and Land Utilization Act*, 1958 (NO. 6372) and Section 5 (1) (b) of the *Land Conservation Act*, 1970 (No. 8008) do by this Proclamation define the water supply catchment areas to be known as the Tennent Creek Water Supply Catchment.

The area proclaimed is the catchment to a reservoir constructed by the Westernport Waterworks Trust, on Tennent Creek, with Crown allotment 150, Parish of Corinella.

The use of land within this catchment is subject to specification by notice or by determination made by the Soil Conservation Authority, acting under the provisions of Section 22 (2) and 23 (1) (a) (b) and (c) of the *Soil Conservation and Land Utilization Act*, 1958, as amended.

The area described is indicated on Plan No. S-738 hereunder, the original of which if lodged at Head Office of the Soil Conservation Authority, 378 Cotham Road, Kew, 3101.
