ROSSLYNNE RESERVOIR (RIDDELL CREEK) WATER SUPPLY CATCHMENT

PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia, &c., &c., &c.

I, THE Governor of the State of Victoria in the Commonwealth of Australia, by and with the advice of the Executive Council of the said State and in pursuance of the provisions contained in Section 22 (1) of the *Soil Conservation and Land Utilization Act* 1958 (No. 6372), and Section 5 (1) (b) of the *Land Conservation Act* 1970 (No. 8008), do by this Proclamation define the water supply catchment area to be known as the Rosslynne Reservoir (Riddell Creek) Water Supply Catchment.

The area proclaimed is the catchment to that part of the Riddell Creek and its tributaries which lie upstream of a diversion point to be constructed by the State Rivers and Water Supply Commission, adjacent to the line where the west boundary of CA1, Section B, Parish of Gisborne meets Riddell Creek.

The use of land within this catchment is subject to specification by notice or by determination made by the Soil Conservation Authority, acting under the provisions of Section 22 (2) and 23 (1) (a) (b) and (c) of the *Soil Conservation and Land Utilization Act* 1958, as amended.

The area is indicated on Plan No. 2526 hereunder, the original of which is lodged at the Head Office of the Soil Conservation Authority, 378 Cotham Road, Kew, 3101.
