ROCKLANDS RESERVOIR WATER SUPPLY CATCHMENT PROCLAIMED 17TH
SEPTEMBER, 1958, "VICTORIAN GOVERNMENT GAZETTE NO. 84" PURSUANT TO
SECTION 22, ACT 1947.

NOTICE OF DETERMINATION OF LAND USE.

In pursuance of the provisions contained in Section 23, sub-section (1) of the *Soil Conservation and Land Utilization Act* 1958, the Soil Conservation Authority, after consideration of all available information with respect to the land described in the Schedule hereto, and after consultation with the Land Utilization Advisory Council by Resolution dated 31st August, 1959, made the following determination in respect of land use:-

- (a) That in the public interest that part of the area which is Forest Reserve be retained as such and used for forestry and water conservation purposes.
- (b) That the area already alienated may be used for pasture and grazing, provided suitable erosion control and soil conservation methods are adopted by the owners of such land.

SCHEDULE

All that piece of land in the Parishes of Tyar, Daahl and Yat Nat within the boundaries of the Rocklands Catchment, consisting of approximately 40,000 acres.
