

Priorities for Salinity Management



To manage salinity the water cycle must be in balance. Landscapes need perennial vegetation to mop up excess water. Perennial options in farmland include lucerne, perennial grass pastures, tree belts and farm forestry.





Funding for recharge and discharge management works is available in salinity priority areas.

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
