

Soil Conservation and Land Utilization Act 1958

EPPALOCK WATER SUPPLY CATCHMENT PROCLAIMED 20TH JULY, 1960 "VICTORIA GOVERNMENT GAZETTE",
NO. 71

Pursuant to Section 22 of the "*Soil Conservation and Land Utilization Act 1958*" (No. 6372).

In pursuance of the provisions of section 23, sub-section 1, of the *Soil Conservation and Land Utilization Act, 1958* (No. 6372), the Soil Conservation Authority has determined land-use for all that area of land in the Parish of Newham within the Eppalock catchment delineated and distinctively marked on Plan No. 1123, the original of which is lodged at the head office of the Soil Conservation Authority. All land within this area shall be used in accordance with the provisions of the particular category of land-use to which each area has been assigned.

The provision of each of the land-use categories determined for this area are set out hereunder:-



Land to be permanently used for forest purposes where forestry operations may be carried out under the supervision and control of the Forests Commission acting as agent for the Authority and where no subdivision for residential purposes shall be permitted.



Land which may be used for forest purposes, but which, if approved by the Authority, may be developed for grazing or agricultural purpose or, if warranted, for residential purposes, subject to conditions imposed according to the particular circumstances, such conditions to include -

- (a) the degree of clearing permissible;
- (b) the specification of those areas where timber shall be retained;
- (c) the specification of those areas where subdivision for residential purposes would be permitted.



Land which may be used for grazing or agricultural purposes, but where if warranted, subdivision for residential purposes will be considered subject to conditions approved by the Soil Conservation Authority.

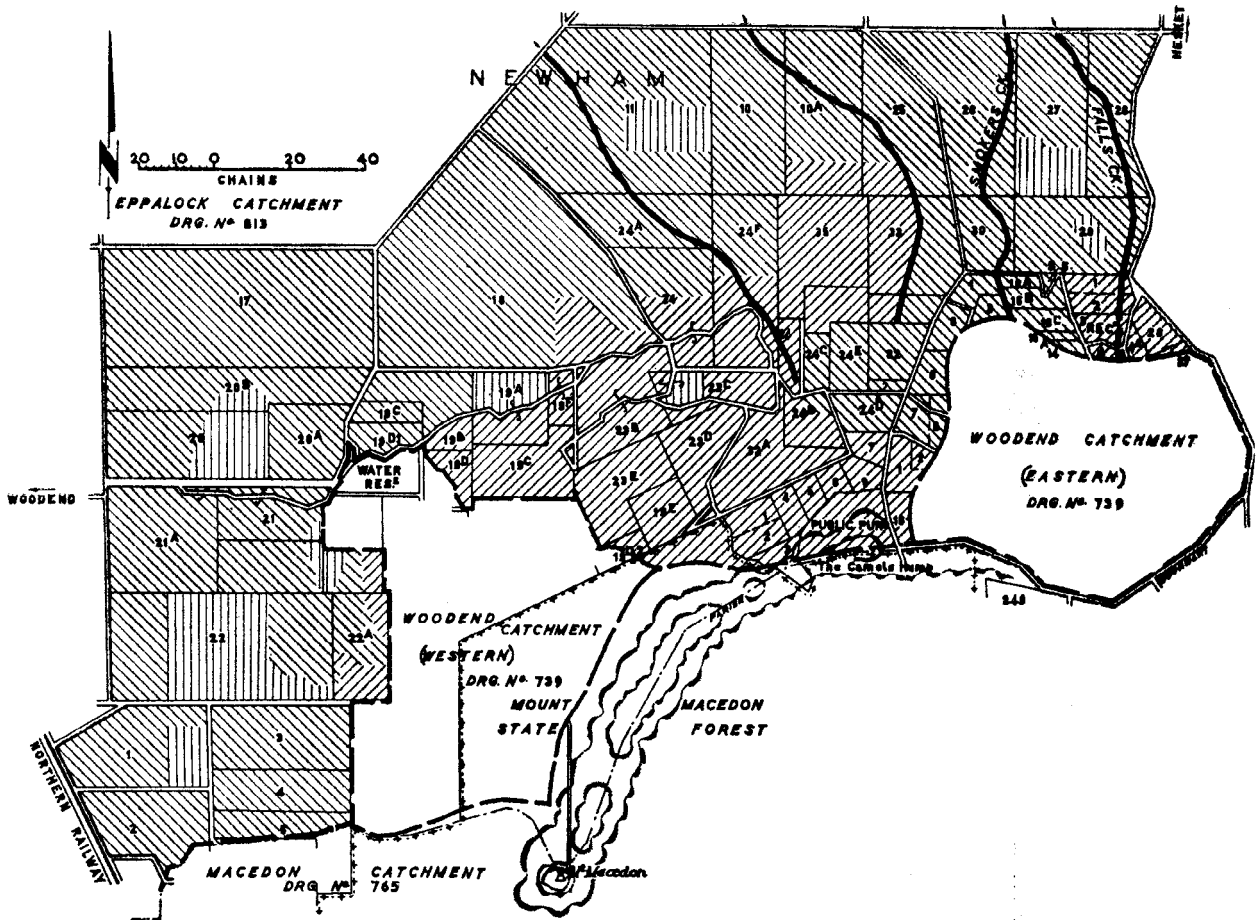


Land within a minimum of 1 chain or such greater distance as the Authority may require from specified streams, springs, offtakes or storages, on which land-use shall be subject to conditions imposed by the Soil Conservation Authority, but in no circumstances shall permissions be given for -

- (a) cropping, and
- (b) erection of buildings



Land reserved for roads and other public purposes on which any changes from the existing nature and conditions shall be made only after consultation with the Authority.
