CAIRN CURRAN WATER SUPPLY CATCHMENT

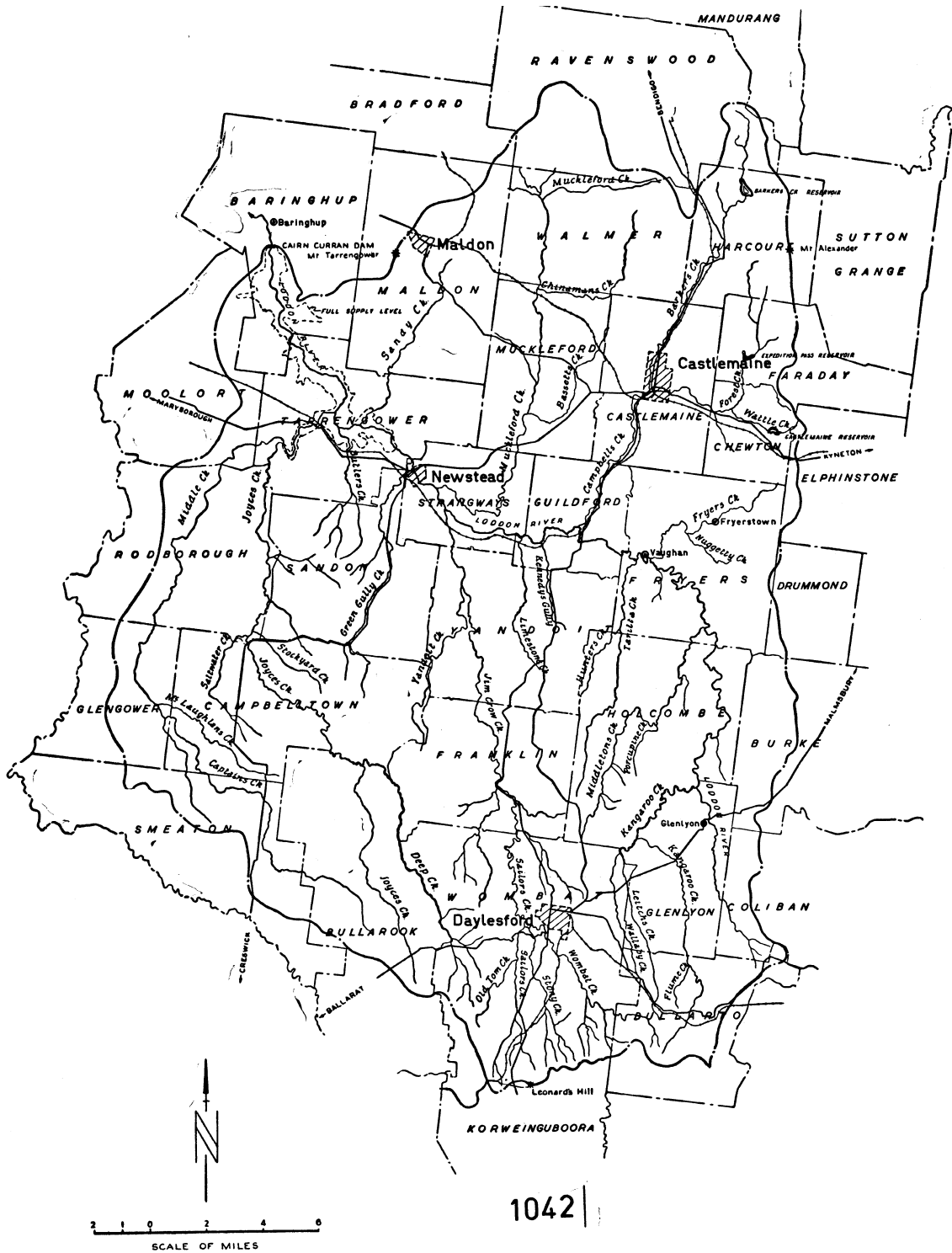
PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia, &c., &c., &c.

I, THE Governor of the State of Victoria in the Commonwealth of Australia, by and with the advice of the Executive Council of the said State and in pursuance of the provisions contained in section 22 of the *Soil Conservation and Land Utilization Act 1958*, do by this Proclamation define the water supply catchment area to be known as the Cairn Curran Water Supply Catchment.

Commencing at the eastern end of the Cairn Curran Dam on the Loddon River in the Parish of Baringhup; thence following the watershed of the Loddon River upstream from the dam in a south-easterly and generally north-easterly direction through the Parishes of Baringhup and Maldon, via Mt Tarrengower; thence continuing in a generally north-easterly direction through the Parish of Maldon in the Parishes of Bradford and Ravenswood; thence in a generally south-easterly and easterly direction through the Parish of Ravenswood into the Parish of Walmer; then turning generally northerly through the Parishes of Harcourt and Ravenswood, and turning in a generally southerly direction into the Parishes of Mandurang, Ravenswood and Harcourt to Mount Alexander, from where the catchment boundary follows the watershed between the Loddon River to the west, and the Coliban River to the east; thence in a generally southerly direction through the Parishes of Faraday, Chewton, Elphinstone, Drummond, Fryers and again Drummond, Burke, Coliban and Bullarto, where the watershed joins the Great Dividing Range; the said watershed between Mt Alexander and the Great Dividing Range has previously been described as part of the boundary of the Eppalock Water Supply Catchment in the Victoria Government Gazette No. 71, dated 20th July, 1960; thence in a generally westerly direction through the Parish of Bullarto and following the boundary of the Parishes Wombat and Korweinguboora via Leonard's Hill; thence through the Parishes of Wombat and Korweinguboora to a point west of Leonard's Hill where the catchment boundary leaves the Great Dividing Range; thence following the watershed in a generally north-westerly direction via Mt Prospect in the Parish of Wombat, and through the Parishes of Bullarook, Smeaton; thence in a generally northerly direction through the Parishes of Glengower, Rodborough, Moolort, and Baringhup; thence across the Cairn Curran Dam to the point of commencement.

This area described is more particularly defined on plan no. 1042 hereunder, the original of which is lodged at the Head Office of the Soil Conservation Authority, 378 Cotham Road, Kew. E4.
