DJERRIWARRH RESERVOIR WATER SUPPLY CATCHMENT

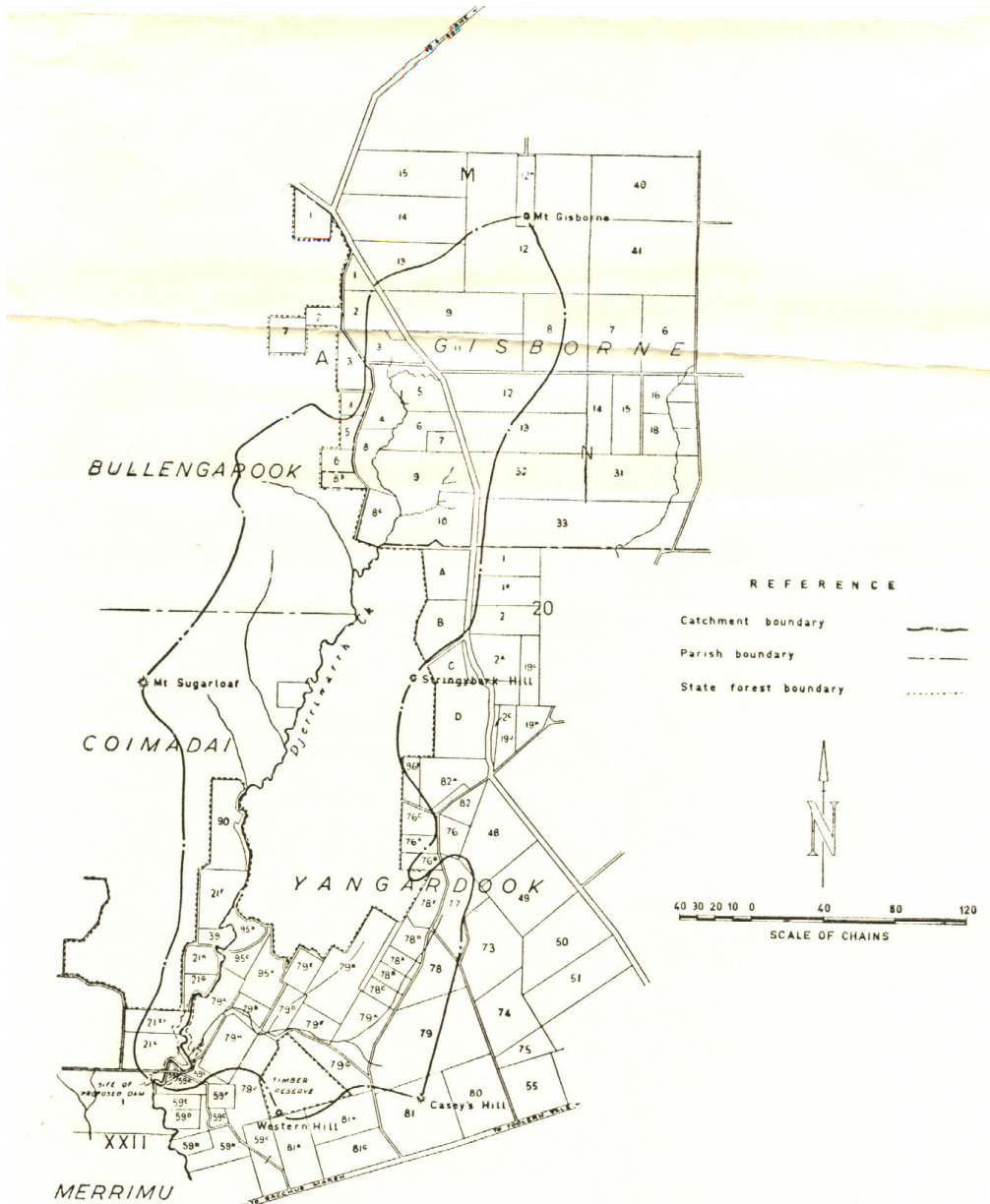
PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Lieutenant-Governor of the State of Victoria and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia, &c., &c., &c.

I, the Lieutenant-Governor of the State of Victoria in the Commonwealth of Australia, by and with the advice of the Executive Council of the said State and in pursuance of the provisions contained in Section 22 of the Soil Conservation and Land Utilization Act 1958 (No. 6372), do by this Proclamation define the water supply catchment area to be known as the Djerriwarrh Reservoir Water Supply Catchment.

Commencing at the western end of Djerriwarrh Dam site on the Djerriwarrh Creek, in town allotment 1, section XXII, Parish of Merrimu and following the watershed of the Djerriwarrh Creek upstream from the dam site, north-westerly across the north-eastern corner of the said allotment to the road reserve on the boundary between the Parishes of Merrimu and Coimadai; thence generally northerly in the Parish of Coimadai through Crown allotments 21L, 21E¹ and the State Forest to Mt Sugarloaf; thence in a generally north-easterly and south-easterly through the State Forest in the said parish into Crown allotment 5, section A; thence northerly through Crown allotments 4, 3 section A, into the Parish of Gisborne; thence continuing in the said parish through Crown allotments 3, 2 and 1, section L; thence north-easterly through Crown allotments 13, 14, 12 and 12A, section M, to Mt Gisborne; thence in a generally southerly direction through Crown allotments 12A, 12 and 8, section M and 12, 13, 32 and 33, section N, into the Parish of Yangardook; thence continuing in the said parish through Crown allotments, 1, 1A and 2, section 20; thence south-westerly through Crown allotment B into the State Forest to Stringybark Hill; thence southerly through the State Forest into Crown allotments 96B, 82A, 76C, 76A, 76B, back into the State Forest, turning north-easterly into Crown allotments 76B, 77 and 76; thence in a generally direction through Crown allotments 81, 79, 79G, Timber Reserve, 81A, 81B and again into the said Timber Reserve to Western Hill; thence north-westerly through the said Timber Reserve to Crown allotment 79J; thence in a generally westerly direction through Crown allotments 79J, 79H, 59L and 59K, parish of Yangardook, and across the Djerriwarrh Dam Site to the point of Commencement.

The area described is more particularly defined on plan No. 116, hereunder, the original of which is lodged at the Head Office of the Soil Conservation Authority, 378 Cotham Road, Kew.
