MICK'S CREEK WATER SUPPLY CATCHMENT

PROCLAMATION

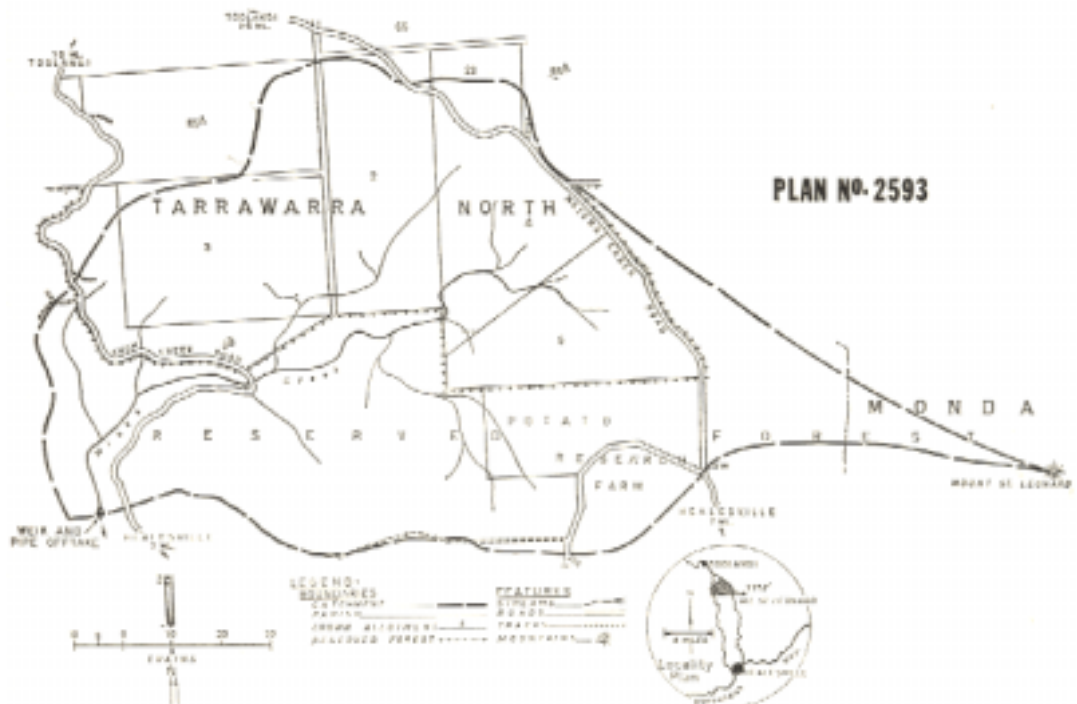
By His Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia, &c., &c., &c.

I, the Governor of the State of Victoria in the Commonwealth of Australia, by and with the advice of the Executive Council of the said State and having considered a recommendation of the Land Conservation Council in pursuance of the provisions contained in section 22 (1) of the *Soil Conservation and Land Utilization Act 1958* (No. 6372) and section 5 (1) (b) of the *Land Conservation Act 1970* (No. 8008) do by this Proclamation define the water supply catchment area to be known as the Mick's Creek Water Supply Catchment.

The area proclaimed is the catchment to the Healesville Waterworks Trust offtake weir on Mick's Creek, in Reserved Forest in the Parish of Tarrawarra North, and including the area within a radius of 5 chains downstream of the offtake weir.

The use of land within this catchment is subject to specification by notice or by determination made by the Soil Conservation Authority, acting under the provisions of section 22 (2) and 23 (1) (a) (b) and (c) of the *Soil Conservation and Land Utilization Act 1958*, as amended.

The area described is indicated on Plant No. 2593 hereunder, the original of which is lodged at Head Office of the Soil Conservation Authority, 378 Cotham Road, Kew, 3101.
