**MACEDON, WOODEND AND MOUNT MACEDON WATER SUPPLY CATCHMENTS**

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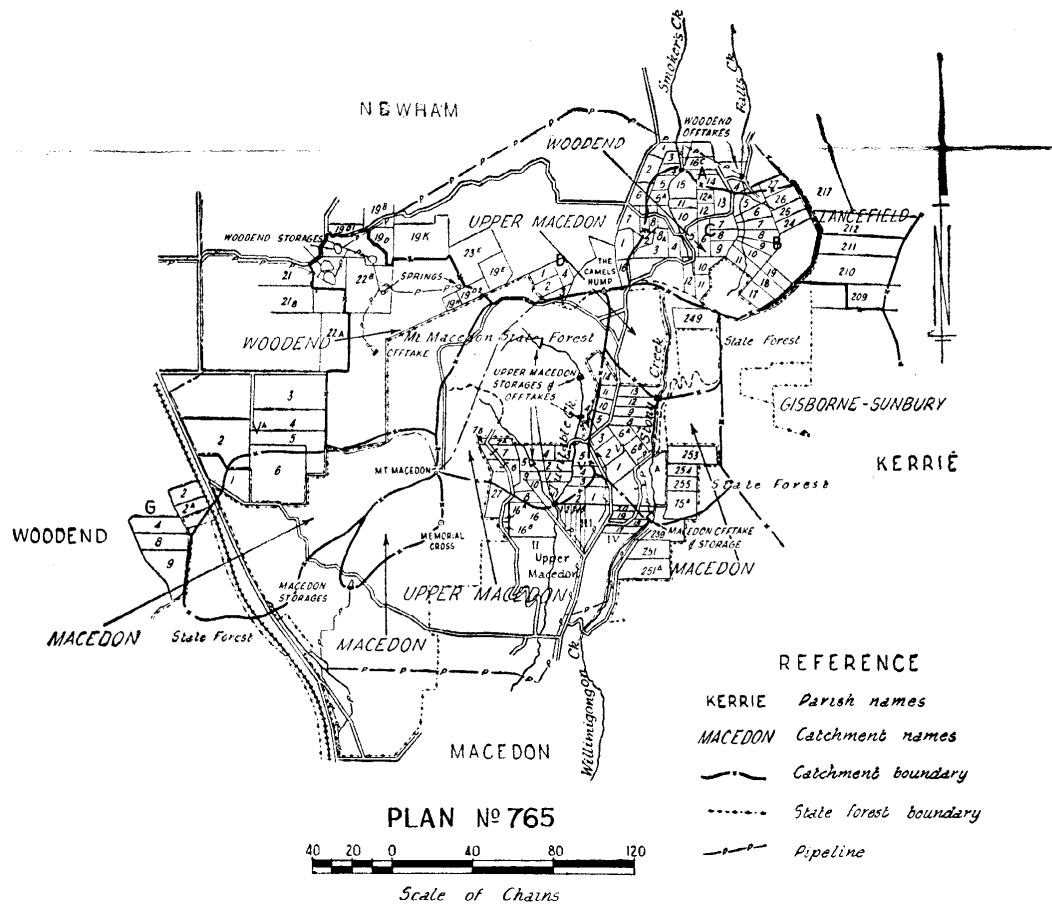
**PROCLAMATION**

By His Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia, &c., &c., &c.

I, THE Governor of the State of Victoria in the Commonwealth of Australia by and with the advice of the Executive Council of the said State and in pursuance of the provisions contained in section 22 of the *Soil Conservation and Land Utilization Act 1958* do by this Proclamation define the water supply catchment area to be known as the Macedon, Woodend, and Mount Macedon Water Supply Catchments.

Commencing at a point in the Parish of Macedon on the Stony or Willimigongon Creek downstream from the Macedon storage reservoir on the eastern boundary of Crown allotment 18, section IV; thence north-westerly across Crown allotments 18, 19, 20 and section IV and Crown allotment A to the south-east corner of Crown allotment 3, section V and along the road to the east of that allotment to its north-eastern corner; thence westerly along the northern boundary and south-westerly across Crown allotments 3 and 2, section V to the pipe off-take Turitable Creek near the northern boundary of Crown allotment 1, section III; thence in a westerly direction across Crown allotments 10 of section VII, 16 of II, 8 of section VII, and 27 of section II to the western boundary of that allotment approximately 5 chains from its north-western corner; then westerly through State Forest Reserve to the summit of Mount Macedon; then southerly, south-westerly, northerly and south-westerly through the State Forest, across the Northern Railway line and continuing westerly through the State Forest to the Great Dividing Range to the eastern boundary of Crown allotment 5, section 5A, Parish of Newham; thence northerly along the eastern boundary of Crown allotments 5, 4 and 3, section 5A, easterly and northerly along the boundary of Crown allotment 22A of section II, northerly and westerly alongside and through Crown allotment 21, section II; thence northerly and easterly along a Country Roads Board road to the north-western corner of Crown allotment 19D, section II; thence following the western, southern and eastern boundaries of that allotment to the south-western corner of Crown allotment 19G, section II, thence easterly along the southern boundary of that allotment; thence south-easterly along the western boundary of Crown allotment 23E and across Crown allotment 19D, section II, and the State Forest Reserve to the Great Dividing Range, thence easterly along the Range over The Camel's Hump to a point in a Timber Reserve (south-east of Crown allotment 16) where the line of watershed to Smoker's Creek leaves the Divide; thence northerly through sections C and A to a point on Smoker's Creek downstream from the pipehead basin east of Crown allotment 4, section A; thence easterly to a point on Fall's Creek downstream from the pipehead basin on that creek; thence easterly through Crown allotments 5 and 27, section B, to a road on the eastern boundary of section B, thence easterly through southerly and westerly along the road between the line of watershed to Fall's Creek in the Woodend catchment and Deep Creek in the Lancefield catchment and Barringo Creek in the Gisborne-Sunbury catchment to a road forming the eastern boundary of Crown allotment 249, Parish of Kerrie, thence southerly by a line through the State Forest to the north-eastern corner of Crown allotment 253; thence southerly by the eastern boundary of Crown allotment 253 to the south-east corner of that allotment; thence south-easterly and south-westerly through the State Forest to the south-east corner of Crown allotment 75A; thence westerly through the northern part of Crown allotment 239 and along the southern boundary of Crown allotment 26C (reservoir reserve) to the commencement point on the Stony or Willimigongon Creek.

The area described is more particularly defined on Plan No. 765 hereunder, the original of which is lodged at the Head Office of the Soil Conservation Authority, 378 Cotham Road, Kew.
