BATTERY CREEK (FISH CREEK) WATER SUPPLY CATCHMENT

PROCLAMATION

I, J. Davis McCaughey, Governor of Victoria, acting with the advice of the Executive Council having considered a recommendation of the Land Conservation Council under section 5 (1) (b) of the *Land Conservation Act 1970* (No. 8008) and acting under section 22 (1) of the *Soil Conservation and Land Utilization Act 1958* (No. 6372), define the water supply catchment area to be known as the Battery Creek (Fish Creek) Water Supply Catchment area.

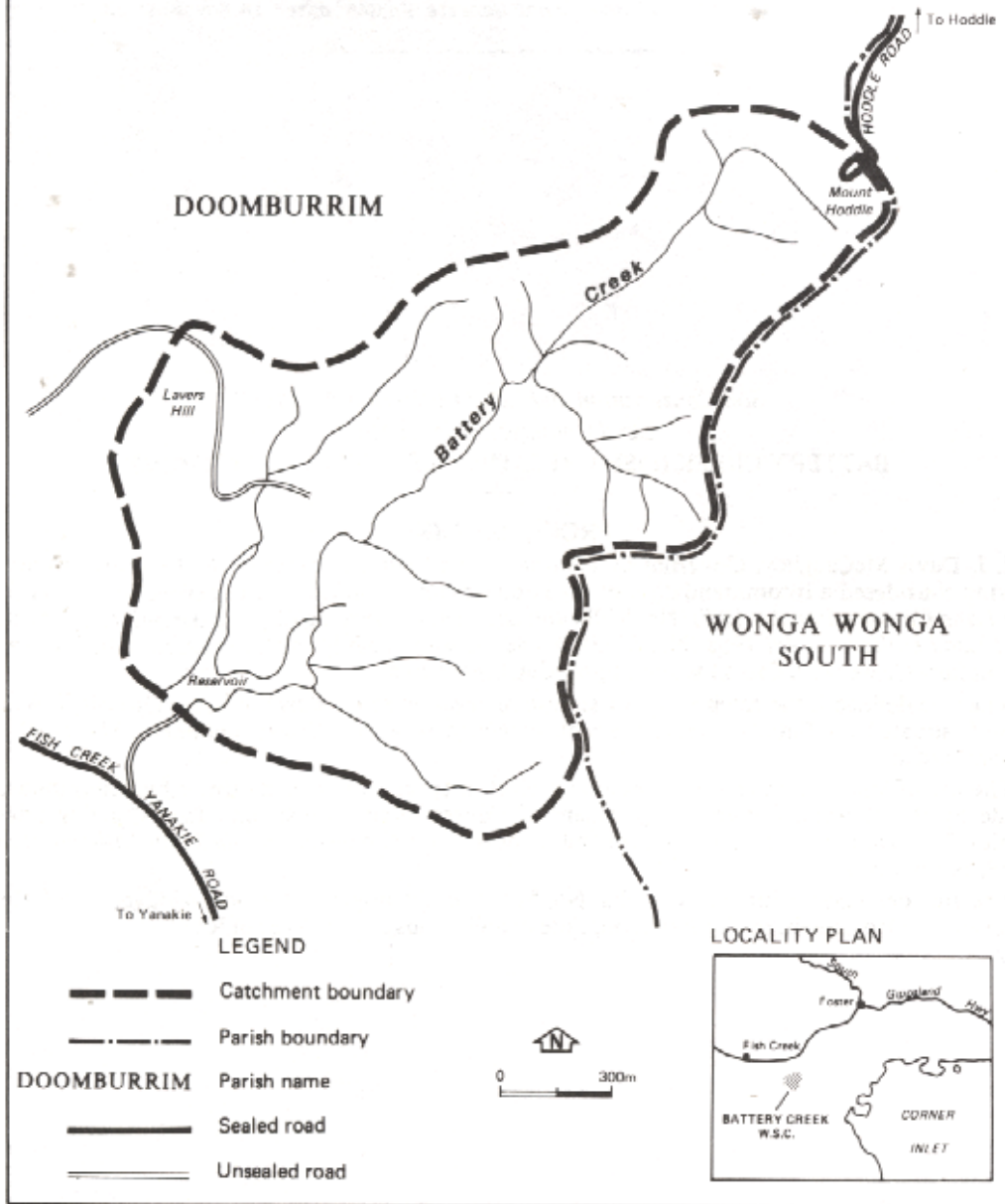
The area defined is the catchment to a storage reservoir controlled by the South Gippsland Water Board, situated on Battery Creek, the wall of which is within Crown allotment 51, Parish of Doomburrin.

The of land within this catchment is subject to specification by notice or by determination made by the Director-General, Department of Conservation, Forests and Lands, acting under section 22 (2) and section 23 (1) (a), (b) and (c) of the *Soil Conservation and Land Utilization Act 1958*, as amended.

The area described is indicated in Plan No. S-1452E, the original of which is lodged at the Kew office of the Department of Conservation, Forests and Land at 378 Cotham Road.
