
Notice is hereby given that the Soil Conservation Authority in pursuance of its powers under the *Soil Conservation and Land Utilization Act* 1958, as amended, has specified the changes in land use which may not be made without the prior approval of the Authority, in a specified part of the Lal Lal Reservoir Water Supply Catchment as defined on plan no. 2739, the original of which is kept at the Head Office of the Soil Conservation Authority at 378 Cotham Road, Kew.

The changes in land use which may not be made without the prior approval of the Soil Conservation Authority are:-

Within the area shaded on the plan no. 2739 -

The burning or clearing of forest or scrub land, the ploughing or cultivation of land, and Within the whole specified area shown on plan no. 2739 -

- 1. The erection of houses, the erection of or addition to buildings associated with enterprises which produce waste discharges.
- 2. The construction of roads or dams, the commencement of any extractive industry or earthworks.
