ROCKLANDS RESERVOIR WATER SUPPLY CATCHMENT


PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia, &c., &c., &c.

I, THE Governor of the State of Victoria in the Commonwealth of Australia by and with the advice of the Executive Council of the said State and in pursuance of the provisions contained in section 22 of the Soil Conservation and Land Utilization Act 1947 do and by this Proclamation define the water supply catchment area to be known as the Rocklands Reservoir Water Supply Catchment:

Commencing at the northern abutment of the Rocklands Dam in the Parish of Yat Nat; thence along the watershed dividing the flow of water to the Rocklands Reservoir from that flowing away from it, in a general easterly and northerly direction through the Parishes of Yat Nat, Tyar, Daahl, Mokinya, Knaawing, Wing Wing, and Burrong South; thence generally in a southerly direction through the Parishes of Burrong South, Boreang East; thence following the eastern boundary of the Parishes of Boreang East and Jalur to the watershed between the head of the Glenelg River and Dwyers Creek; thence generally in a westerly direction along the watershed through the Parishes of Jalur, Larneebunyah, Woohlpooer, Geerak, Moralla, Beear, Wookurrook to the western boundary of that Parish; thence generally northerly along the western boundary of the Parishes of Wookurrook and Pendyk; thence generally north-easterly through the Parish to the southern abutment of the Rocklands Dam and across the structure to the commencing point.

The area described is more particularly defined on plan No. 652 hereunder the original of which is lodged at the Head Office of the Soil Conservation Authority, 378 Cotham Road, Kew:-
