GENERAL DESCRIPTION

Shallow valley cut into the basalt plain by various streams. The valley usually has moderately steep very short slopes on one side and gentle on the other – alternating as the stream meanders. The top lip of valley may be rocky.

LAND ASSESSMENT

- A Erosion Risk with Land Disturbance
 - Class 2 Shallow stony soils on any steep slopes. Some stream bank erosion may occur.
- B Constraints on Construction
 - Class 3 Variable slope & rockiness
- C Effluent Disposal by Soil Absorption
 - Class 4 Close to creek
- D Small Farm Dams
 - Class 4 rock, slope

OVERALL ASSESSMENT FOR RURAL SUBDIVISION 2-10 ha (Considering A, B, C & D)

- Class 3-4 Pollution risk
